



What is a Webinar?

Short for Web-based seminar, a **webinar** is a presentation that is transmitted over the internet. A key feature of a Webinar is its interactive elements -- the ability to give, receive and discuss information. Fund for Teachers shares PowerPoints and other documents while speaking directly with participants via a conference line.

How do I participate in a webinar?

To participate in a Fund for Teachers webinar you must register by emailing rsvp@fundforteachers.org. Provide your name, school, city and state in your email.

Fund for Teachers will send you an email on the day of the presentation with the following information: topic, date, time, meeting number and meeting password. The email will also contain links to the presentation site.

Note: School districts will often block emails from third parties. Please add messenger@webex.com to your safe list or address book.

Webinar participants must have a current version of Flash player to view presentations online.

Do I have to participate online?

No. Participants may join the presentation by phone if they are unable to access a computer or prefer only to listen. The invitation email will include the conference line number and access codes.
